This set of worksheets feature 2022 calendar sheets that include guidelines and examples for each name of the month. Trace then write one on your own! If you'd like to get some more practice in, there are also additional worksheets for each month.

These worksheets work best with small to medium sized brush pens.

I recommend printing the calendar sheets on cardstock, clipping them together, and hanging on a bulletin board or wall.

I recommend printing the additional worksheets on  
HP Premium32 printer paper.

If any of your pages are getting cut off during printing, be sure to adjust printer settings to "fit to page".

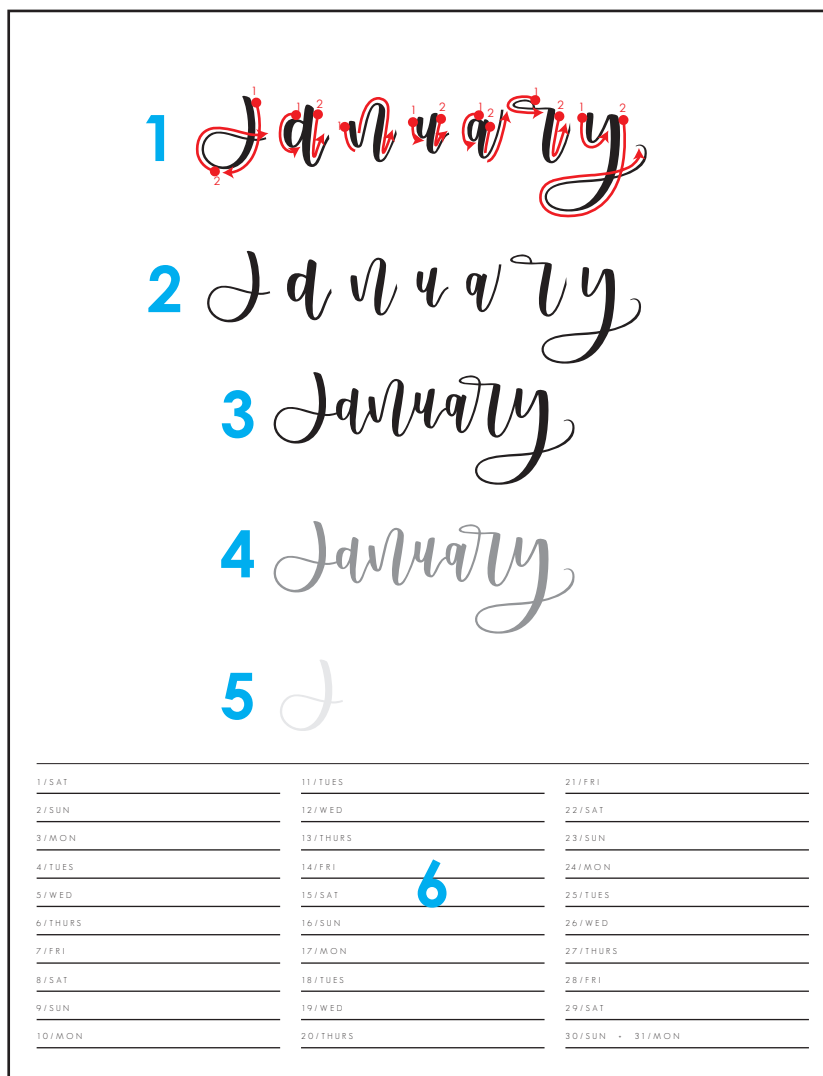

# HOW TO USE THE CALENDAR SHEETS



1) The first example on this page includes stroke order and guidelines for how to create each letter. The letters have spaces in between them so you can see how each individual letter is created.

The red DOT shows you where to begin.

The red ARROW shows you what direction to move in.

Each NUMBER represents a new stroke--this is where I will either PAUSE with the pen still on the paper OR PICK UP my pen and start a new stroke. *Pausing/picking up is up to you and what feels most comfortable for each letter.*

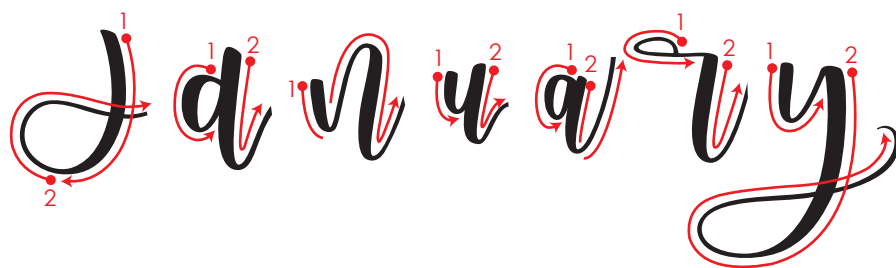
2) The second example does not include the guidelines so you can clearly see each letter.

3) The third example shows the letters connected together and how the final word will look.

4) The fourth example is in grey and for you to trace.

5) The last letter is in light grey and it's for you to trace and finish the rest of the word on your own.

6) The bottom portion is the calendar.
